Filled with the Spirit: The seven disciples chosen by the Jerusalem church to “*serve tables*,” free the apostles to devote themselves “*to prayer and to the ministry of the word*” were to be “*men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom*” (**Acts 6:3-4**). Christians generally are commanded to be “*filled with Spirit*” (**Eph. 5:18**). Christians full of the Spirit, obviously, will manifest the “*fruit of the Spirit*” (**Galatians 5:22**). But in the context of **Ephesians 5:19**, the text suggests three results of being “*filled with the Spirit*”: 1) addressing one another in singing; 2) giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father; and 3) submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.
