Intelligent Design: Obvious design denotes a designer. Complex intricate design denotes an intelligent designer. A battery watch, such as I wear on my wrist, does not appear set to the correct time and running as a result of an explosion in a watch factory. Even if it did, it would still show design by the parts that came together to make a watch. David said in **Psalm 139:14**, *“I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made.”* Consider the eye, in the lower animals and perhaps perfected in man. Light, reflected off an object, comes to the eye and in connection with nerves in the brain enables the person to see the object as it is. It would take dozens, perhaps hundreds, of beneficials (evolution’s change makers) in a precisely correct order just to make an eye. Complex design requires an intelligent designer!
