And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

<u>Mark 16:16</u> - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Paul wrote the book of Romans to believers in Jesus at Rome (Rom. 1:7) to show that all human beings are sinners in need of salvation (CHS 1-3), what God did to save us, and how we can have a right relationship with Him (4-11). After explaining the theological foundation of the gospel (1-11), the apostle instructed believers in Christ how to live in a right relationship with God (12-16). The last four chapters provide a pattern of discipleship, teaching believers how to respond to God's mercy and grace (12:1-2), how to use spiritual gifts (12:3-8), and how to relate to different people in the church and society (12:9-16:27). Though Jesus died to save us, God doesn't demand that we die for Him. Rather, we are to live for Him in His perfect will (12:1-2), in humility (vs. 3) and in unity (vv.4-8).

<u>Prayer is a privilege</u> – don't forget to use it! After all, "*The* earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results." James 5:16 (NLT)

In Jn. 7, we learn that Jesus was teaching and healing in Galilee and staying out of Judea "because the Jewish leaders there were looking for a way to kill him" (v. 1). Whether out of fear, jealousy, or something else, they wanted him gone. Yet when the Feast of Tabernacles approached, Jesus travelled to Jerusalem in Judea to observe the weeklong festival, the Jewish leaders attempted to have Jesus seized (vv. 20, 43-44). Instead of heading home after the festival, He stayed in Judea (7:53-8:1). He went to the temple to preach, and there the teachers of the law and Pharisees brought the woman caught in adultery (8:6). However, their attempt to entrap Jesus failed (v. 9). Afterward, Jesus forgave her of her sins, telling her to sin no more! Even after the stress of the entrapment, Jesus took the time to talk to and forgive this woman. What a wonderful Savior!
