Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

James 4:7 - *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

Mark 16:16 - *Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

In Ephesians 1:2-14 Paul delivers a doxology – or song of praise to God. Paul writes to gentile believers in Jesus, assuring them of their adoption (vs. 5) into an unparalleled inheritance. When he says, “*we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ*” (v. 12), he is referring to the Jews. Yet he is quick to include “*you,*” that is, the Gentiles, who also believed (v. 13). And he gives us great hope: we are “*marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance*” (vv. 13-14).

Prayer is a privilege – don't forget to use it! After all, “*The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.*” **James 5:16** (NLT)

In Lk. 10 Martha and her siblings are hosting Jesus in their home in Bethany. Martha is busy preparing a meal for Christ and his disciples and is upset Mary isn't helping (Lk. 10:38-40). In Jn. 11, we learn of Lazarus' illness and death. When Jesus says to Martha, “*I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live....do you believe this?*” She replies “*yes...I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world*” (vv.25-27). The last time we see Martha, she is again preparing a meal, but this time she doesn't protest that Mary isn't helping (12:1-2). Perhaps she has learned the importance of the “*one*” thing (Lk. 10:42-42 – listening to, learning from, and worshiping Jesus.
