And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 16:16 - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

<u>Destruction Destroyed</u>: Sin and death entered the world as a result of Adam and Eve's disobedience to God, and the deception wrought by "that ancient serpent, who is the devil" continues (Rev. 20:2). But Jesus came "to destroy the devil's work" (1 Jn. 3:8), and through Him we are restored to a relationship with God. "He will make everything new" (Rev. 21:5). Jesus' beloved disciple John recognized in the serpents' temptation of Eve in Gen. 3:1-7 and the fundamental temptations all people face. He wrote that "everything in the world-the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye, and the pride of life – comes from the – world" (1 Jn. 2:16). His words echo Eve's though as she looked at the tree: it was good for food, pleased the eye, and would make one wise like God (Gen. 3:6). We all face the same kinds of temptations (1 Cor. 10:13). Instead of giving in, however, the Spirit will help us to stand firm in the faith (Gal. 5:16; 1 Peter 5:8-9).

All the Answers: Jesus' disciples had learned to look to Him for all the answers. Now on the eve of his crucifixion, He assured them He wouldn't leave them alone. "I will ask the Father and He will give you another advocated to help you and be with you forever – the Spirit of Truth" (Jn. 14:16-17). He extended that comfort to all who would believe in Him. "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them" (vs. 23). Those who chose to follow Christ have within them the Spirit who teaches them "all things" and reminds them of everything Jesus taught (v. 26). When we pray in the Spirit, we ask not out of selfishness but according to the "will of God." We have that "will" written in the New Testament. Read it!
