And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

<u>Mark 16:16</u> - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

#### Seek First the Kingdom of God:

Jesus knew our days would crash one into another in a sea of ceaseless urgency. So, he instructs us, "*But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you*" (Mt. 6:33). It's natural to hear Jesus' words as a command. And they are. But there's more here – an invitation. In Mt. 6, Jesus invites us to exchange the word's frantic anxiety (vv. 25-32) for a life of trust, day by day. God, by His grace, helps us all of our days – even when we get to number eighteen on our list before we remember to see life from His perspective. How can we turn to God first each day? On stressful days, what helps you trust Jesus with things demanding your immediate attention? The life of faith includes a trust in our heavenly Father because of things that can be seen – the birds of the air and the lilies of the field, these things help to show us that God really does care for us and is there for us. When you need to slow down try praver and Scripture reading.

**In the Garden:** Adam and Eve walked in the Garden with God. In the Garden was the tree of life – and Adam and Eve were allowed to eat of it. After Adam and Eve rebelled against God, they were expelled from the garden and were separated from the tree of life. They now had to plant and care for their own gardens and battled with weeds and other challenges. Yet God continued to provide for them, Gen. 3:21. The garden imagery in Genesis chapters 2 and 3 prepares Bible readers for the use of that phrase elsewhere in the Bible. Proverbs speaks of wisdom as a tree of life to those who take hold of her, 3:18. In Revelation, the future Edenic existence for believers in Jesus comes into view (Rev. 22:2, 14, 19). Indeed, a beautiful garden like existence awaits the people of God – where the tree of life will line the river of the water of life and give off fruit each month. No longer will there be anything accursed, and the people of God will see his face and God will reign forever.
