And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

James 4:7 - *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

Mark 16:16 - *Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

In **Psalms 20**, King David took comfort in God's trustworthiness. The Israelites had a powerful army, but they knew that their biggest strength came from "*the name of the Lord*" (v. 7). They placed their trust in God's name – in who He is, His unchanging character, and unfailing promises. They held on to the truth that He who is sovereign and powerful over all situations would hear their prayers and deliver them from their enemies (v.6).

While God may use the resources of this world to help us to ultimately; victory over our problems comes from Him. Whether He gives us a resolution or the grace to endure, we can trust that He will be to us all that He says He is. We don't have to be overwhelmed by our troubles, but we can face them with His hope and peace.

Psalms 20:7 – *Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.*

Prayer is a privilege – don't forget to use it! After all, "*The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.*" **James 5:16** (NLT)

Romans 8:9-17:

You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

Insight into Rom. 8:9-17: Paul describes believers in Jesus as being "*children of God*" (Rom. 8:14). We have received "*adoption to sonship*" (v. 15) and no longer live as fearful slaves. To call God the Father "*Abba*" describes the family relationship and the boldness that believers can have when they approach Him. The word sonship is important because it implies inheritance. Paul is not erasing daughters but instead showing that all believers are now "*heirs of God*" (v. 17). Through the Spirit, believers stand next to Jesus as full "*co-heirs.*" The adopted children of God have the same full rights as the Son, and the Spirit seals that privileged status (v. 15). God has changed our spiritual heritage. He adopts us into His family. Most precious of all – He invites us to call him our Father. (borrowed)
