And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 16:16 - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Psalm 118:6 "The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?" When the psalmist faced attack, he responded with confidence rather than fear, he had this confidence because he knew he did not face those treats alone. Instead, he wrote the above passage. As a Christian I have slowly learned from years of walking with Christ that He is greater than any fear inducing treat. The threats we face in life are real. Yet we need not fear. The Creator of the universe is with us, and He is more than enough. This passage came from a series of Psalms read, or sung, at Passover each year. Psalm 118 is the second most quoted psalm in the N.T. with only Psalm 110 surpassing it. When Jesus entered Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, the crowds shouted the words of Psalm 118:26, proclaiming Jesus as the king to free them from Roman bandage (Mt. 21:9; Mk. 11:9; Lk. 19:18, Jn. 12:13). Christ quoted Psalm 118:22-23 in the parable of the tenants (Mt. 21:42; Mk. 12:10-11; LK. 20:17). Peter cited these same verses in Acts 4:11 and 1 Peter

2:7, and Paul alludes to them in Eph. 2:20-21. Hebrews 13:6 quotes from Psalm 118:6. This lends strong credence to Psalm 118:6 – "The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?" Is there something you are afraid of today? Then take it to the Lord in prayer. As the song goes, not a shadow can rise, not a cloud in the skies, but his smile quickly drives it away; not a doubt

nor a fear, not a sigh nor a tear, can abide while we trust and obey.
