And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

James 4:7 - *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

Mark 16:16 - *Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

Compassion in Action: Col. 3:12 – *Clothe yourself with compassion.* I once heard compassion explained like this: *To make people's lives just a little bit better, in any way I can.* As practiced by Jesus, compassion is a feeling so strong that it leads us to take action to meet another's need. When crowds of desperate people pursued Jesus, we are told that "***he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd***" (**Mk.6:34**). He turned that compassion into action by healing their sick (**Mt. 14:14**). We too should "***clothe ourselves with compassions***," Paul urged in **Col. 3:12**. All around us are needs, and God will bring them to our attention. Those needs can motivate us to put our compassion into action, and those actions will encourage others as we show them the love of Christ. Here is a small prayer you might like to pray: Lord as I see pain and need, soften up my heart to act with Christlike compassion. The word translated "compassion" in Col. 3:12 combines two Greek words (bowels) and (mercies), or *bowels of*

mercy. Figuratively this refers to tender emotions that compel kind, merciful, compassionate responses. As Christ's representatives (**Col. 3:17**) believers in Jesus are urged to "***clothe***" themselves "***with compassion***," along with other Christlike characteristics (**12-14**). This Greek verb "***splanchnizomai***" ***compassion***, is used only in the gospels to describe divine action – that is how God or His representatives act. We also see it in the story of the prodigal son – "***While he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son...and kissed him.***" When was the last time you showed compassion?
