Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 16:16 - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Extreme Kindness: Titus 3:4-5: When the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us.

Jehoiachin, the exiled king of Judah, was also the recipient of extreme kindness. He had been incarcerated for 37 years before the benevolence of the Babylonian king resulted in his release. Jer. 52:31-32 says, "And in the thirty-seventh year of the exile of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the twenty-fifth day of the month, Evil-merodach king of Babylon, in the year that he began to reign, graciously freed Jehoiachin king of Judah and brought him out of prison. And he spoke kindly to him and gave him a seat above the seats of the kings who were with him in Babylon."

This story pictures what happens spiritually when, out of no contributions form themselves or others, people who believe in Jesus' death and resurrection are rescued from their estrangement from God. They are brought from darkness and death into light and

life; they are brought into the family of God because of the extreme kindness of God. Insight: The prophet Jeremiah is often referred to as the weeping prophet because his book of prophecy contains several references to tears, including his own personal sorrow. Jeremial wasn't afraid to cry! Some students of Scripture have speculated that some in the crowd thought Jesus was Jeremiah (Mt. 16:14) because he wasn't ashamed of His tears. What acts of human kindness have reminded you of God's goodness? How do you respond to the kindness of God who welcomes you into His family based on what Jesus has done?
