And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 16:16 - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Ready to Pray: Join me in my struggle by praying to God for me, **Rom. 15:30.** Believers in Jesus desperately need help from others too. The most powerful help we can offer is prayer. In Rom. 15:30 Paul wrote, "I urge you, brothers and siters, by our Lord Jeus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me." Paul asked them to pray that he would "be kept safe from the unbelievers in Judea" and that the "Lord's *people*" would receive him and his gifts favorably (v. 31). He acknowledged the rewards of being a part of their community (v. 32). He stood with them in prayer too, ending his letter with a blessing: "The God of peace be with you all." As we live for Jesus, we will face adversaries in the physical and spiritual realms. God promises to be with us and fight on our behalf, however, as we stand together...always ready to pray. Insight on Rom. 15:30-33: When Paul asked believers in Jesus to "join" him in earnest prayer, the Greek word used conveys the idea of straining or striving together.

Like athletes struggling to reach the finish line, he wanted the Roman believers to wrestle faithfully with God in prayer for the challenges he would soon face. Paul's concerns about the likelihood of facing fierce opposition in Judea (v. 31; Acts 20:22-25) were well founded. In Acts 21-27, we read about what the apostle experienced there. He was seized by a mob and arrested (21:12-15) by religious leaders who conspired to murder him (23:12-15), and he spent two years in prison before finally being sent to Rome (24:27; 26:32-27:1). This likely wasn't what Paul was hoping for when he asked for prayers "to be kept safe," but he was able to trust in "God's will" (v. 32) and powerful presence. Though God did keep him safe from being murdered by the Jewish leaders in an ambush. As believers in Jesus, we can also trust in the one who's with us and who will fight for us.
