Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

<u>James 4:7</u> - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 16:16 - Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

<u>Shooting ourselves in the foot:</u> <u>Mk. 10:35</u> – "Teacher, they said, we want you to do for us whatever we ask."

Sometimes we can figuratively shoot ourselves in the foot with misguided ambitions. James and John knew what it meant to ambitiously seek something good, but for wrong reasons. They asked Jesus to "let one of us sit at your right and the other at your left in your glory" (Mk. 10:37). Jesus had told the disciples they would "sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel" (Mt. 19:28). So, it is easy to see why they made this request. The problem? They were selfishly seeking their own lofty position and power in Christ's glory. Jesus told them that their ambition was misplaced (Mk. 10:38) and that "whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant" (v. 43). As we aim to do good and great things for Christ, may we seek His wisdom and direction – humbly serving others as He did so well (v. 45). Insight into Mk. 10:35-45: James and John might see shockingly presumptuous in

their request for position of prominence in Jesus' coming messianic kingdom. But perhaps we should be more understanding. Jesus had recently told them that the 12 would sit on thrones and judge Israel, Mt. 19:28. Their misguided request took place soon after that statement. Christ corrected them, "you don't know what you are asking" (Mk. 10:38). Then he referred to a cup and a baptism (v. 38, symbols that represent not prestige but suffering. Jesus would drink the cup of God's wrath by enduring crucifixion. The disciples would later face persecution as well. James would be beheaded, as the first apostle to be put to martyrdom. We have all been called to suffer for Christ – that is to bear our own cross for Jesus. Here is how James 1:2-4 puts it, "Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. Where do you stand in asking Jesus for favors?
