Sermon Topics:

Morning: Know Your Bible

Evening: The Promise of Drawing Near to God and God drawing near to Us.



Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

James 4:7 - *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

Mark 16:16 - *Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

Just Like Jesus: Romans 12:2 - *Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.*

Blending might be a useful mechanism in nature; however, God invites all people to receive salvation and stand out in the world by how we live. The apostle Paul urges believers in Jesus to honor God in every aspect of our lives, to worship Him by offering our bodies as a “*living sacrifice*” (**Rom. 12:1**). Due to our fragility as human beings affected by sin, our spiritual health as believers depends on the Holy Spirit “*renewing*” our minds and empowering us to avoid conforming to “*the pattern of the world*” that rejects God and glorifies sin (**v. 2**). Blending into this world means living in opposition to the Scriptures. However, through the power of the Holy Spirit, we can look and love just like Jesus.

Insight into Romans 12:1-2: Paul wrote the book of Romans to believers in Jesus at Rome (**Rom. 1:7**) to show that all human beings are sinners in need of salvation (**ch. 1-3**), what God did save us, and how we can have a right relationship with God (**ch. 4-11**). After explaining the theological foundations of the gospel (**ch. 1-11**), the apostle instructed believers in Christ how to live in a right relationship with God (**ch. 12-16**). The last four chapters provide a pattern of discipleship, teaching believers how to respond to God’s mercy and grace (**12:1-2**), how to use spiritual gifts (**vv. 3-8**) and how to relate to different people in the church and society (**12:9-16:27**). Though Jesus died to save us, God doesn’t demand that we die for Him. Rather, we are to live for Him in His perfect will (**12:1-2**), in humility (**v. 3**), and in unity (**vv. 4-8**). Have you been blending into the world to remain unnoticed, or have you been standing out for Christ?
