Grief – **Genesis 23:2**, *“And Sarah died at Kiriath-arba (that is, Hebron) in the land of Canaan, and Abraham went in to mourn for Sarah and to weep for her.”*

We love and lose everything from spouses to children to parents to friends, and weeping with “painful joy” is so very human. Yet for the believer in Jesus, our weeping only last for the proverbial night. As David wrote, *“Weeping may stay for the night, but rejoicing comes in the morning” (Ps. 30:5)*. Our Father hasn’t left up bereft of hope.

Abraham and Sarah went through a lot together – from Ur to Palestine, following the promise of God. Many mishaps, missteps, and years later, elderly Abram and Sarai, now renamed Abraham and Sarah, became the joyful parents of Isaac, the fulfillment of God promise. Sarah died at the age of 127, and Abraham wept over her. We too will face grief, but God will lovingly provide the hope and comfort we need.

God comforts us with the thought that through the resurrection from the dead, we will one day see our loved ones in Christ again. In the meantime, they are in Paradise awaiting us to join them – in comfort.
