**John 14:1-6** *“Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. In my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. And you know the way to where I am going.” Thomas said to him, “Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?” Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.*

Here is another of the great “*I AM*” saying in John, showing the divinity of Jesus. Jesus is the one whom men come to God – not only did He teach the way, but He is ***the Way*** – ***no one comes to the Father except through me***. The only way to God is through the person of Jesus Christ. Being full of grace and truth, He is ***the truth*** – the truth about God and about salvation. He is ***the life*** because the life of the Father is in Him. He gives spiritual life, eternal life to all who believe. Because he is both God and man, he is all-sufficient and shows us the way to God.
