Mark 16:16 - *Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

Rom. 2:6-11

For God shows no partiality.

It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people’s feet. “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”*
