Mark 16:16 - *Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

Isaiah 40:11 – *He carries the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart.*

There is almost nothing like the overwhelming love and tender compassion of a parent providing healing comfort for a child. We see this powerful imagery in the prophet Isaiah’s description of God with His people.

Even after prophesying impending exile for the nation of Israel because they had rejected God (**Isa. 39:5-7**), Isaiah emphasized to the people that God still loved them and would always provide for them. God’s tender compassion and secure care is evident in the beautiful metaphor where He is described as a shepherd who, much like a loving father, gathers His sheep “*in his arms and carries them close to his heart.*”

God’s presence grants us peace and protection and reminds us that He carries us close to His heart, like a newborn baby with its mother. As He “*gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak*” (**vs. 29**), the Spirit’s healing comfort allows us to meet the challenges of each day.

Vs. 31 – “*but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on the wings of eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.*”
